


Mondello - Mozia - Castelvetrano - Mondello


A day trip today to explore the western end of Sicily including the famed salt works at Mozia as



necropolis so well preserved even after nearly 27 centuries! Return to Mondello for **dinner**. (**B.D**)






Saturday 24 September Mondello - Cefalu' - Madonie - Taormina

Heading off this morning to the fishing village of Cefalu', we will have a chance to visit and explore the town and its iconic cathedral. A stop in the Madonie Mountains will allow us to see the village of Polizzi Generosa with a sampler **lunch** of local specialties before transiting Sicily to reach Taormina on the east coast - reach Grand Hotel Capotaormina (3 nights) in time for **dinner**. Sunday 25 September

Taormina

A relaxing day today with a detailed look at lovely Taormina, perched on the slopes of Etna with Greek-era theater and lovely shopping streets. The afternoon will be free, with **dinner** of local specialties (enjoying a long seacoast, Sicily is known for its seafood!)! (**B.D**)





Monday 26 September Taormina - Etna - Taormina

Today's adventure will take us to Mount Etna, 3,000 meter high volcano which has been a symbol of Sicily since the days of Greek domination. Do you remember the Odyssey? Polyphemus, the Cyclops, lived here in mythology! A cable car ride and degustazione wine tasting on the slopes of Mt. Etna will complete our excursion! Back to Taormina for seaside **dinner** this evening! (**B,D**)

Tuesday 27 September Taormina - Reggio di Calabria

A free morning today for a final look at Taormina with time to relax and explore (shopping, ladies!) before heading to the ferry that will take us to Calabria. Overnight in Reggio di Calabria with **dinner** Hotel Excelsior (2 nights). (**B,D**)

Wednesday 28 September Reggio di Calabria

A day of guided exploration of Reggio di Calabria, including a visit

to the bronzes of Riace, a pair of remarkably well-preserved Greek warrior statues from the VI-c BC that were rediscovered on the sea floor roughly 35 years ago. Farewell **dinner** this evening of local Calabrian specialties! (**B,D**)

Thursday 29 September Reggio di Calabria - Rome - Newark

Early alarms this morning as we will transfer to the local airport for our return flights, AZ 1154, from Reggio to Rome (06h55-08h10) with connecting service via AZ 642 to Newark (10h15-13h50) (airport seat assignments, as always with group travel). From Newark we will embark our charter bus returning to Laurel, with ETA 18h45.
